

Beachcomber Mauritius Ladies Open introducing a new dimension to ladies golf

The Beachcomber Mauritius Ladies Open taking place from the 30th April to the 4th May on Mont Choisy golf course wants to give a new dimension to ladies golf, said Nathalie Serret, President of the Ladies Golf Union, during the presentation of the event at Beachcomber headquarters in Curepipe on Thursday 4th April. This tournament replaces the Mauritius Ladies Open Indian Ocean held during the last six years with golfers from Mauritius, Reunion Island and Madagascar.

For this new edition, golfers from other countries from the Indian Ocean region have also been invited to take part, namely from Africa, Australia, Dubai and India. The registration is open until the 15th April and concern amateur players with a handicap 36. The ladies will be split into three categories: Under 18 years old, 18 to 60 years old and under 60. Besides, four professional golfers from South Africa, France and Great Britain will also be attending the Beachcomber Mauritius Ladies Open and will lead golf clinics before the tournament.
